As Thanksgiving quickly approaches this week, we want to take a moment to thank you for your continued support throughout this pandemic. Our facility has faced unprecedented challenges over the last eight months and we appreciate your patience and understanding as we do our best to ensure your loved ones remain safe.

We are extremely grateful that you have entrusted your loved ones to our care and we are making every effort to provide our residents with a wonderful Thanksgiving. And while the recent rise in COVID-19 cases all over the country has affected how we all are celebrating this holiday; our facility will be serving a full Thanksgiving spread on Thursday during lunch.

Also, as a reminder, visitations for the holiday are as follows:

- We are open to closed window visits
- Telephone calls anytime
- FaceTime calls as scheduled with the Activity Director

As a reminder, our total number of cases to date are as follows: 16 residents and 13 staff members have tested positive for COVID-19 up to date, thus far. Unfortunately, we have had a spike in cases with 9 staff members and 15 residents testing positive for COVID-19 yesterday, November 23rd. While we are disappointed that so many individuals have tested positive for COVID-19, we will continue to work with our state and local health authorities to take the necessary steps to prevent further spread of this virus in our facility.

Our regular weekly updates will resume next week and we will continue to update you on our website if we receive notifications of new confirmed cases of COVID-19. As always, if you have any questions or concerns please don't hesitate to contact us directly.
